Two new ways to share your exam success:


1. Share a **Tweet or LinkedIn post** directly from the Candidate Portal. Look for the social sharing icons.

How do I share my exam success?



Step 1: Click 'Create Badge'



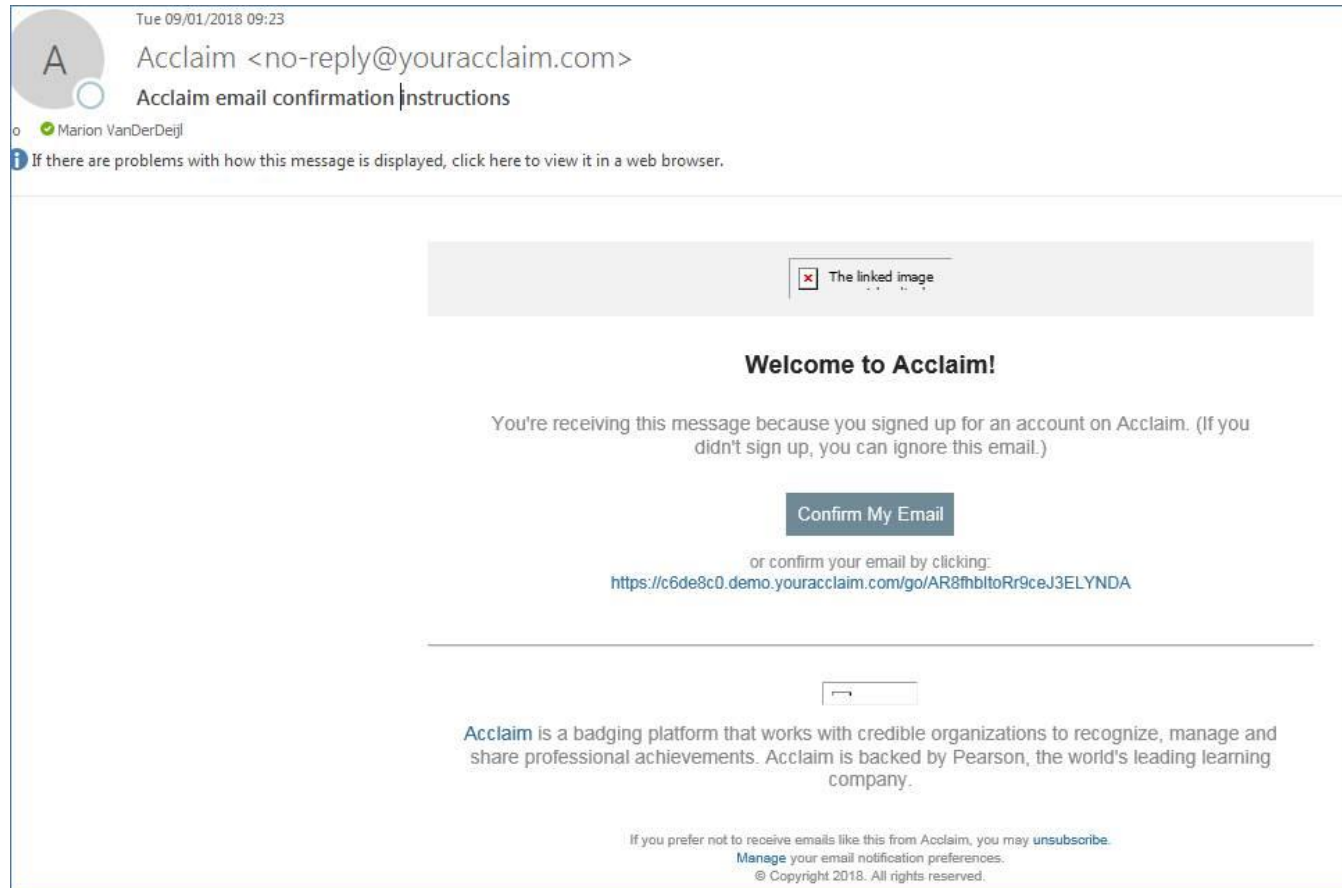
Clicking 'Create Badge' takes you to the Acclaim website, where you will be guided through the process.


